
An address to the Rev. John Richard and Mrs Hill, June 29th 1892

This illuminated address was given to the Rev. John and Mrs Hill on the occasion of their Golden Wedding on June 29th, 1892. In addition to being the Vicar of Thornton, the Rev Hill was also Lord of the Manor and owned much of the property in Thornton and surrounding villages. An address to the Rev. John Richard and Mrs Hill Thornton from the Tenantry, June 29th 1892

We, the undersigned, being tenants on your estate, desire to offer you our most hearty congratulations on this eventful occasion of the 50th anniversary of your marriage commonly called the "*Golden Wedding*".

We desire to express our gratitude that in the good Providence of God you have been spared to enjoy so many years of happiness together, and we pray that still in the future more happy years may be in store for you.

We assure you that we duly appreciate the fact, that like your much respected father, you have spent your life in the midst of your people, and have been ever ready to consider and further their welfare and interests, and from this, and from the knowledge that you never disturb your tenants, we have a feeling of security in the possession of our holdings.

We recognise with thankfulness the great help you have given in the matter of Education by building Schools and supporting them so liberally.

We also do not forget your deep interest and generous aid in the restoration of the Parish Church.

We humbly pray that the blessing of God may rest upon yourselves and your family in the time to come.
