

# THORNTON LE DALE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes for Parish Council Meeting No 13

Held Tuesday 5 March 2019 at 7.30pm in The Hill Memorial Institute

## PRESENT

The meeting opened at 1930 hrs with Councillors S Bell (Chair), J Garbutt (Vice Chair), G Acomb, P Charles, M Sanderson, D Porter, J Sanderson (NYCC) and 13 members of the public.

Mr Richard Marr – Area Manager (Highways & Transportation) NYCC gave a presentation on the Parking & Management Review in Thornton le Dale.

In summary the issues raised by the report were as follows

### PEDESTRIAN CROSSING.

The nature of the evidence collected does not activate any major changes to the junction, although a scheme has been drawn up which would use a 3 way traffic light system at a projected cost in the vicinity of £125,000. Unfortunately there is no available funding to justify the signalisation scheme.

### ROAD MARKING & PARKING + 7.5T Weight Restriction on Whitby Gate.

Whitby Gate, Malton Gate, Roxby Road, A170, all the road marking in these areas will be reviewed including adjusting the areas of parking and adding double yellow lining in certain areas. This would be done in conjunction with local residents.

### ZEBRA CROSSINGS on A170 and MALTON GATE.

These areas are not considered to be road safety issue and no funding is available to undertake such work.
