Highways Pelican Crossing I was very concerned to hear about the accident on the pelican crossing. It appears that the elements we are all aware of combined to cause the circumstances for the accident to happen, but of course I await the police report.

There have been ongoing discussions with Highways and as previously reported, there are no ideal options. Setting aside the cost of fully signalising the junction, the main concerns are –

- 1. The space to place additional sets of lights.
- 2. The potential to cause queuing on the A170 which in itself could be dangerous.

The "Yellow Box" has been removed to trial the idea put forward by the parish council.

The "Diversion" sign at the corner of Whitbygate has compounded the issues at the crossing. This was thought to be a Highways Agency sign for the A64 diversion, but it would now appear to be connected to work down Westgate. Investigations regarding the conflict of signage are ongoing.
